Before school begins in August, there are some things you need to do. They aren't homework in the sense that you have to read something and answer questions, but they will make the first day of class run more smoothly if you do them.

1. Be sure you meet the requirements to be in the class. SLCC requires a Reading ACT score of 18+ or an Accuplacer score of 75+. You should have taken care of this before the end of the school year. If you didn't, you need to contact SLCC's Student Testing Services at 801-957-4500 as soon as possible to take care of that.
2. You need to purchase the textbook for this class. They will be available for purchase at any SLCC bookstore by the last week of July. The nearest bookstore is at the Jordan Campus of SLCC (3491 W. 9000 S. in West Jordan). The cost will be approximately \$40 new. The textbook is:

The Academic Writer by Lisa Ede 3rd Edition

You can buy a new or a used version. You will know you have the right edition because it has a **blue striped cover**. Do NOT buy the textbook if it is bundled with the SLCC Reader. You need the textbook only.

You don't have to purchase it from SLCC, but that will guarantee that you get the correct book.

3. You need to register with SLCC as a CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT student. To do so you need:
 - Your social security number
 - A credit/debit card to pay your \$40 tuition (or you can go to a campus and pay in person)

If have already taken concurrent enrollment classes, you are already enrolled and will just need to pay the fees.

When you come the first day of class, you must have your S number with you, which you will get when you register.

And that's it. Have those items taken care of, and we'll start the year off well.
